UNKNOWN DIGITAL SCREENING CASES

A series of 50 baseline screening mammograms will be presented, many with subtle cancers. Radiologists will be asked to rate unknowns as "normal" or "re-call." Test may be taken Friday afternoon before and/or after lectures on Friday evening, including all day Saturday. Dr. Bird's Saturday lecture will present the correct answers and discussions. Test scores for those reviewing the case files twice (Friday afternoon and Saturday) will be compared for improvement. Friday afternoon participants will receive an extra hour of digital mammography credit. There is no extra charge for this activity as it is being supported by an in-kind donation. Number of participants is limited.
